Fred, John, and Richard Rumiano emigrated from Italy. In the early 1900's, after jobs in gold mines, shipyards, and liquor, they settled near Willows in 1919 and began the dairy operation. The creation of the Monterey Dry Jack cheese launched the company, primarily serving the regional market and San Francisco.

Second-generation manager Ray Rumiano expanded into new markets such as Asia and outside of California, and developed innovative techniques for processed and plant-based cheese. After Ray passed on, his two sons, Baird and John, returned to save the company, opening up new
